RX Drug Drop Box Program

Prescription opiates are often the gateway to heroin addiction. Prescription opiates are commonly found in many medicine cabinets. It is vital that old prescriptions be properly disposed of to keep one's family safe. Pills left unattended in a bathroom or medicine cabinet can be easily taken and misused. Please utilize Cuyahoga County's Rx Drug Drop Box Program to keep your loved ones safe. It's easy! Just log into RxDrugDropBox.org and type in your zip code to find a box near you. Most police stations in Cuyahoga County have a box available for your use 24/7. A drop box is located in the Bedford Police Department lobby located at 165 Center Road.

Household Hazardous Waste Round-Up

August 1 - 31

The following can be dropped off at the Service Garage, 100 Solon Road, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (NO AFTER HOURS DROP OFF); Oil or solvent based paint, sealers, primers, or coatings - Varnishes, polyurethanes, shellacs - Paint thinner, mineral spirits, turpentine - Pesticides, herbicides, fungicides - Caustic household cleaners - Automotive fluids, motor oil, car batteries - Adhesives, roof tar, driveway sealer - Kerosene, gasoline, lighter fluid - Mercury, florescent bulbs.

No latex paint accepted, Bedford residents only.

LATEX PAINT DISPOSAL
Dry it up. Throw it out.
Water-base paint is not hazardous and should be disposed of in the trash.

Latex paint is not accepted in the Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Program. It can be cleaned up with water and is not flammable.

To solidify latex paint

- Air dry
- Use a drying agent: cat litter, sawdust, plaster of Paris, Oil-Dri or "waste paint hardeners" found at home improvement centers
- When the paint is dry, discard it with your regular trash. Leave the lid off so the waste collector can see the paint is hardened
